- Dispense and adjust analog and digital hearing aids as well as other amplification devices.
- Maintain patient confidentiality and comply with HIPAA rules and procedures.
- Maintain patient information and complete required clinical documentation.
- Work closely with Ascent Hearing Center leadership and staff to maximize patient care and workflow processes.
